## How to Get Involved:

- **Register your interest in Site-Finder**

To Register for Site-Finder's notifications, just [sign up here](#). You'll get a monthly newsletter letting you know what's new on Site-Finder, outlining our 'Site of the Month', and informing you of news from the Global Health Network. You can also choose to join other areas of the Global Health Network at the same time, or you can like the Global Health Network on [Facebook](#), or follow us on [Twitter](#).

- **Add your Research Site**

To register your research site, first you need to register yourself (see above), or log in. Then, simply click on 'add a research site' and enter your information. You can use the helpdesk to ask any questions, no matter how big or small!

- **Add a Research Study**

If you are planning a research study, you can add it to SiteFinder, even if you haven't necessarily finalised the detailed or protocol yet. With increased number and diversity of the sites involved, planned studies might be improved and completed faster. First you need to register yourself (see above), or log in. Then, click on 'enter a study'. Remember to use the helpdesk if you need to!
